

Adopting a Loriendale Devon

We like to collect a little information about our kitten owners so we can assure the best home for each kitten. You will find a link on the website below this link

The kittens leave home desexed, fully vaccinated (2x), vet checked, wormed, micro chipped, litter box trained, registered (New Zealand Cat Fancy and National Register of Companion Animals) and of course dearly loved. They leave the cattery around 13-14 weeks old once they have recovered from the desexing operation.

Our Odd Eyed kittens are \$3000

White and all solid-coloured kittens are \$2500

All other colours are \$1750

This includes 2 vaccines, worming, vet checked x2, desexing and micro chipping and microchip registration, registration with New Zealand Cat Fancy and a copy of a cattery pedigree. Six weeks free pet insurance

There is also the cost of travel which is approx \$265 within the SI and approx \$365 to the NI.

We use Kris Archer at Flying Paws NZ. We can no longer deal directly with the airlines and they now require an certified Pet Transporter to deal with them.

I also require an airline approved carry cage that are often available on Trade Me for \$50 or you can send one you have to me. Kris can also provide these but not sure what she charges.

Once you have chosen a kitten a non refundable deposit of \$500 is required to hold the kitten for you.

During waiting for the kitten you will receive our Loriendale Kitten care which covers all sorts of things from diet, preparing for the arrival, things you will need to purchase for the kitten, general healthcare and loads more.

As you can expect our kittens are sort after and they don't seem to be "available" for long. We do have a number of people on our waiting list and priority is given to those who have been waiting longest if there is a kitten that fits their requirements. Everyone seems to have different requirements with colour, pattern and gender so sometimes there will be a kitten that is available to "new additions" to the kitten list.

The best way to see what is happening is visit the website. I also advise everyone on the list when a litter is born and I have identified the colours (this can sometimes take a while).

We sometimes have young breeding cats that we re-home for \$800.
